FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, July 7, 2019-C

We thank Fr. Silvino for his ministry and presence at St. Joseph's this past month and wish him God's blessing as he returns to the Cathedral in Fort Wayne. For the remainder of July, we welcome Fr. Tommy Lane to St. Joseph's. Fr. Lane is a priest from the Diocese of Cloyne in County Cork, Ireland, and, for the past fifteen years, has served as a professor of Sacred Scripture at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD. Welcome to St. Joseph's, Fr. Lane!

A special "Welcome!" to all those who are joining us for the extended 4th of July weekend. Welcome to St. Joseph's! It is my prayer that all have a blessed holiday and that God may keep all travelers this weekend safe in His loving care.

Our bulletin cover is an image of the main entryway of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. The central sculpture in the Roman archway that frames the main door is a relief of the Annunciation. This relief sits atop the greeting of the Archangel Gabriel to our Blessed Mother, "Hail Mary, Full of Grace. The Lord is with Thee" (Luke 1:28). From this greeting comes the biblical basis for the title of Mary as the Immaculate Conception.

In the Gospel, St. Luke relates Gabriel's greeting to Mary by using the Greek word *kecharitomene* (κεχαριτωμένη). This word, used only once in the Scriptures, is taken from a Greek verb, *charitóō* (χαριτόω), meaning "to give grace." *Kecharitomene* is in the past perfect tense of this verb, roughly meaning "one who is and has always been given grace." Gabriel uses this word not as a verb, but as an adjective referring to Mary. For Mary, being *full of grace* is not simply an action, but her very identity. Before she was the Mother of God [*theotokos*] (Luke 1:43), before she was Mother of the Church [*mater ecclesiae*] (John 19:27), she was *kecharitomene*, or "full of grace" (Luke 1:28).

Mary received this great gift as a result of that "singular privilege and grace granted by God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the Savior of the human race." This explanation was beautifully written of by Piux IX in his constitution *Ineffabilis Deus*, which defined *ex cathedra* the dogma of the Immaculate Conception. This dogma, as with all things Marian, points us to Jesus Christ. In the same way, when you enter the Shrine through this door, you see before you an image of our Lord. Mary always leads us to Jesus.

Flanking the main door and the relief of the Annunciation are, on the left, the women of the Old Testament who prefigured Mary (Sarah, Miriam, Ruth, and Naomi). These women lived lives that anticipated, in some form, the role of Mary in the New Testament. On the right, we find the prominent women of the New Testament (Elizabeth, Anna, Mary and Martha, and the Samaritan Woman). Each of these women were greatly involved, in some manner, in the lives of Jesus and Mary.

It is truly amazing how much theology and biblical scholarship we can find in a simple doorway. All of this imagery is before our eyes before we've even entered the Shrine itself. Just like the Blessed Mother, every aspect of a church building is meant to point us to Jesus. In the same way, our very lives, as disciples of the Lord who have been sent out like the seventy-two, are meant to reflect Jesus to the world. Let us ask ourselves a simple question this weekend: When someone looks at us, do they see Jesus?





