# TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME — August 16, 2020

This weekend, the Church celebrates the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time (August 15th/16th). And, in doing so, we are continuing in the fourth great discourse of St. Matthew's Gospel. Having heard of the death of St. John the Baptist, having experienced the feeding of the five thousand, and having met our blessed Lord walking upon the water, we still remain in the very beginning of this discourse! Jesus is preparing His disciples to learn about the Church here on earth, which will be built upon St. Peter as we will hear next weekend.

This continuation in the fourth discourse brings us to today's Gospel reading of Jesus and the Canaanite woman (Matthew 15:21-28). [This same reading is also accounted for in St. Mark's Gospel (Mark 7:24-30), though St. Mark refers to the woman as a Syrophoenician, which would have been the "modern" term for a Canaanite in Jesus' time.] Taken alone, this can often be seen as a very challenging reading as our blessed Lord initially seems to dismiss the Canaanite woman's pleas for help three times.

The first time, Jesus did not even acknowledge her. The second time, He refused His disciples' request on her behalf. And, the third time, Jesus reminds her that He has come for Israel. ("Dogs" was a frequent description of Gentiles [non-Jews] in Jesus' time.) The fourth time, however, Jesus responds with compassion and answers her plea, healing the Canaanite woman's daughter.

When speaking of this passage in the fourth century, St. John Chrysostom highlights the Canaanite woman's perseverance and humility. When contemplating the full dialogue, St. John Chrysostom says that Jesus put the woman off three times so that, at the fourth time, he might crown her as He loudly proclaims "O woman, great is your faith!" As St. Peter would later write, our faith increases through trials (1 Peter 1:6-7). St. John Chrysostom continues by emphasizing Jesus' proclamation to the Canaanite woman. He wasn't simply flattering her, but truly acknowledging how powerful her faith was and, because of this, how He could respond in her life.

Taken in the context of the entire fourth discourse and echoed in our second reading from St. Paul (Romans 11:13-15, 29-32), we see the truth of Jesus' message as revealed in and through His Church: Salvation has come for Jew and Gentile alike. Jesus responds to the Canaanite woman's perseverance, humility, and faith. In the same way, He will respond to all those who approach Him in the same way, Jew and Gentile alike.

Last Friday, we received updated directives from the Diocese for our liturgies. After reviewing these directives, the substantial changes allowed will have little effect on our practices here at St. Joseph's. The majority of the changes regard precautions that we already have in place or are concerning non-liturgical matters that will not affect our weekend liturgies. The updated directives can be reviewed on the diocesan website (diocesefwsb.org) under the section: Current Diocesan Directives Regarding Covid-19.



In the future, we will be looking into the possibility of offering both options, continuing to mail out a bulletin for those requesting it while also making them available in the church after weekend Masses. As always, thank you for your patience as we continue to do our best in outreach during this time.




