

#### THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY-AUGUST 15, 2021

This weekend (August 14th/15th), the Church celebrates the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. This solemnity, though officially declared a dogma of the Church by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950, can be traced back to the earliest centuries of the life of the Church. With the toleration of Christianity by the *Edict of Milan* (311 AD), Christian holy sites would eventually become celebrated locations where churches were built. One such location close to Mount Zion was centered around the empty "*Tomb of Mary*."

At the empty "Tomb of Mary," devotion to the Blessed Virgin was marked with local celebration surrounding Mary's having been taken into heaven. This celebration quickly spread throughout the Church and became known as both the "Dormition of Mary" and the "Assumption of Mary." Though no biblical account is recorded of Mary's Assumption, the tradition and practice of the Church has re-echoed this belief throughout the ages.

At the *Council of Chalcedon* (451 AD), when asked to bring a relic of the Blessed Mother to the council by the Emperor Marcian, the Patriarch of Jerusalem, St. Juvenal, responded that this was not possible. Sharing with the emperor this ancient teaching, he stated that it is known that "Mary had died in the presence of the Apostles; But, her tomb, when opened upon the request of St. Thomas the Apostle, was found empty. The Apostles concluded that her body was taken up into heaven." This belief in the Assumption has continued to be handed on throughout the ages.

The word "Assumption" itself comes from the Latin verb "assumere," which means "to take to oneself." The meaning of the word itself helps to clearly express the teaching of the Assumption: That Our Lord, Jesus Christ, took His Mother home to Himself where He is. In this way, the Blessed Virgin continues to serve as our model, pointing us towards heaven and He with whom she now resides: her Son, Jesus Christ.

Marking this solemnity, though we have spent the past three weekends exploring the Eucharist in the sixth chapter of the Gospel of St. John, we are briefly interrupted by the Gospel of St. Luke. This deviation gives us the opportunity to consider the heavenly destiny to which the Eucharist helps us aspire. It is this same heavenly destiny to which Our Lady has already so gloriously attained and that which we hope to one day share in. Until that time, may we continue to ask the Blessed Virgin to continue to intercede for us to Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

#### TEACHING MASS: AUGUST 22<sup>ND</sup> AND AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup>

In place of our August Discussion Forum, we will once again offer a "Teaching Mass" on both Sunday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, from 8:30 AM - 9:30 AM, and Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, after the 7:00 PM evening Mass. (Note: A "Teaching Mass" is <u>NOT</u> a Mass. It is a walk-through and offers explanations of the various parts of the Mass.) This walk-through offers us a chance to more fully immerse ourselves into the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

A "Teaching Mass" offers the chance to delve into the scriptural, spiritual, historical, and practical aspects of the liturgy itself. As we've focused on the past few weekends: *The way we pray is the way we believe*. As the Mass "is the greatest and highest act of prayer" (Benedict XVI), it exemplifies our belief. We are called to live out the Mass in our daily lives.
