

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT - DECEMBER 6, 2020

These new fixtures not only allow for greater versatility in our lighting design, e.g. the beautiful way that the tabernacle is now lit, but are also more efficient and will require less maintenance than the previous fixtures.

This weekend (Dec. 5/6), we enter the **2nd Sunday of Advent**. Having entered into our new liturgical year last weekend, we will primarily spend this coming year walking with our Lord through the Gospel of St. Mark. In the very middle of this liturgical year, we will have a brief detour from St. Mark's Gospel as we spend several weeks on the Bread of Life Discourse from the sixth chapter of St. John's Gospel. Being in the 2nd of a three year cycle, this means that the Church centers our 3-year reflection of the Sacred Scriptures on the Most Holy Eucharist.

Much in the same way, as we are reflecting on this weekend, we see that the Sacred Scriptures as we hear in our liturgy is meant to prepare us to receive Jesus Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist. The word of God prepares our hearts to receive the very Word of God Himself, Jesus Christ. Everything that we do is meant to call us into this intimate relationship with our Lord.

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary falls this coming Tuesday, Dec. 8th. Though this is a yearly Holy Day, the obligation to attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on this day remains dispensed by Bishop Rhoades due to COVID-19. Though not a Holy Day of Obligation this year, may we see it as a holy day of opportunity. For those able to join us in person, Mass will be offered on Tuesday, Dec. 8th, at 8:00 AM, Noon, and 7:00 PM. The 7:00 PM Mass is offered as a part of our Advent Parish Mission as we welcome Fr. Stephen Felicichia as the homilist.

Speaking of our **Advent Parish Mission**, it starts this Monday! Don't forget to join us **Monday**, **Dec. 7th - Wednesday**, **Dec. 9th**, each evening from **7:00 - 8:00 PM** as Fr. Stephen, parochial vicar of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, lead us in our Advent reflections. The mission can be attended either in-person in the Church or via live-stream on the parish website. Recordings will also be available after each session on the parish Facebook page.

We welcome Fr. Vincent Davila, OP, to St. Joseph throughout the coming week. Fr. Vincent is a member of the Order of Preachers, a religious order also known as the Dominicans (named after their 13th Century founder, St. Dominic of Guzmán). Fr. Vincent is currently working towards his doctorate from Notre Dame in South Bend and is visiting for the week. Prior to seminary, Fr. Vincent and I were roommates at Purdue and are looking forward to catching up over the next week.


