Second Sunday of Lent - March 8, 2020

This weekend, the Church enters into the 2nd Sunday of Lent. In our readings, we hear of the Transfiguration. Our Lord ascends Mt. Tabor with Peter, James, and John and, as they approach the mountain top, He becomes dazzling white and is found speaking with Moses, the giver of the Law, and Elijah, the greatest of the prophets. As quickly as they ascend, however, the moment ends and they must come down from the mountain top. Our Lord gives His Apostles this brief respite on their way to Jerusalem (and to the Cross) to help steadfast them for what is to come.

Just as our Lord shows this moment to His Apostles, so often does He do the same for us with "mountain top" experiences. These can be tremendous moments, such as the birth of a child or a major promotion, to smaller moments, such as doing well on an assignment or simply having a good day. In all of these moments of great joy, we feel that God is right with us. But, as with any mountain top experience, they end much too quickly and our journey, just like our Lord's journey, continues. We are given these moments of joy to serve as a reminder of the eternal joy that we are striving for in the heavenly kingdom.

One such moment that we can enter into so often is found in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In making a good confession, we experience the mercy of God and are given grace to steadfast ourselves as we continue on this earthly journey. Things have bound us are loosed, sins are forgiven, and healing is ushering into our lives. In addition to our 3 weekly hours of Confession and our coming Penance Service, we will join with all other parishes in our Diocese this week for the annual **The Light is On for You!** Campaign. **Every parish in our diocese will offer the Sacrament of Confession this Tuesday, March 10th, from 6:00 - 8:00 PM**. No matter how long it has been, I encourage you to make use of the Sacrament this Lenten season. Climb up the mountain with our Lord and experience His glory in this Sacrament.

A Novena and the Solemnity of St. Joseph

This Tuesday, March 10th, will also begin our St. Joseph Novena. These nine days of prayer will lead us into our celebration of St. Joseph's Day. Please see the insert in this week's bulletin both for an explanation of what a novena is as well as the prayers for the St. Joseph Novena. I encourage you to pray for a specific intention and follow along in this Novena prayer at home. Or, if you would prefer to pray together as a community, we will be praying these prayers after our daily Masses throughout the week. Then, join us for our special evening Mass on St. Joseph's Day on Thursday, March 19th at 7 PM, followed by ice cream in the Social Hall.
