## THE REIGNING CHRIST

This image of Christ, the King, and the symbolism are taken from St. John's Book of Revelation. He wears His emblems of Prophet, Priest and King. He holds seven stars in His hand and His feet rest on the Book of the Seven Seals. The Alpha and Omega flank his head. Seven burning candles appear before His throne with the palms of His victory at the sides. Below is the tomb of the holy martyrs, who are the first to be raised on the last Day.

"The one who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks in the midst of the seven gold lampstands." Rev. 2:1



# OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE NOVEMBER 22, 2020

Join us for Mass on Thanksgiving Day on Thursday, Nov. 26th, at 9 AM. Come and begin your day with the Eucharist (Greek for Thanksgiving) as we give thanks to God from whom all blessings flow. This Mass will also be live-streamed for those unable to join us in person.

Over the past week, we've received many questions regarding the new executive order from Governor Holcomb. After reviewing the order and speaking with our diocese, it is relieving to see that the order does not place limits on religious services. We will continue offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in-person here at St. Joseph's, keeping to the same diocesan safety precautions we have been implementing since May. We will also continue making the Mass available via live-stream for all those who are yet unable to join us in-person.

This raises a great question that speaks to the very heart of our Catholic worship: Why do we go to such great lengths with safety precautions to ensure our in-person worship can continue? Following these precautions as best as we can, we witness to that which must be most essential to us in this life: Jesus Christ present to us in the Most Holy Eucharist. This is why we joyously await the day for when we, as a parish family, can all gather together again in-person at the altar of the Lord to worship our Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist. In the words of St. Thérèse of Lisieux: "In the presence of Jesus in the Holy Sacrament we ought to be like the Blessed in heaven before the Divine Essence.

### Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe & Advent

This weekend brings a close to our liturgical year as we celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Our front cover of this bulletin is a biblical explanation of our stained glass window in the Church that represents this liturgical celebration. Bringing an end to our liturgical year, this yearly feast offers a joyous reminder to all Christians: Jesus Christ is King.

In the words of Pope Pius XI when promulgating this feast day: "Once men recognize, both in private and in public life, that Christ is King, society will at last receive the great blessings of real liberty, well-ordered discipline, peace and harmony." May we strive each and everyday to allow Jesus to be the King of our Heart and, in doing so, to reflect His Kingship in everything that we think, say, and do. If we strive to do this, we will begin to change the world one person at a time, starting with us.

Ending the liturgical year means that, next weekend, we will begin a new year of God's grace as we enter into **Advent**. The season of **Advent** serves as a wonderful time to re-evaluate our relationship with God and to re-focus our lives upon Him. The next four weekends are meant to prepare us to welcome the Incarnation of the Son of God, Jesus Christ.

Throughout **Advent**, we will have a variety of opportunities to grow in the Lord. Available this weekend, our **Little Blue Books** are in the narthex (in both English and Spanish), as well as a number of **Advent Calendars**. Our **Parish Mission will be offered from Monday, Dec. 7th, through Wednesday, Dec. 9th, at 7 PM each evening in the church**, led by Fr. Stephen Felicichia. (*The Mission will also be live-streamed.*) Let us make this an **Advent** that will change our hearts and our lives.


