

According to tradition, Francis of Assisi began the practice of using mangers at Christmas time. Sometimes called the "Saint of the Incarnation," Francis believed that of all the ways God has revealed his love, none is more total and tangible than the Incarnation of his Son. So it isn't surprising that for the midnight Mass, Christmas 1223, in a cave in Greccio, Italy, Francis presented a living re-enactment of the nativity scene. This visual and creative— and apparently first-commemoration of Christ's birth has now become traditional. *Crèche* is a French word meaning manger or crib. - The Catholic Source Book

"Flower of the Holy Night"

Dr. Joel Poinsett was U.S. ambassador to Mexico in the early 1800s. In 1829 when he returned home, he brought with him a plant that the Mexican people called "flower of the Holy Night." We call it the poinsettia, after Dr. Poinsett, and use it as a favorite Christmas plant.

It has a fable origin: Long ago, on Christmas Eve, a poor child made his way to Church in great sadness because he had no gift to offer the Christ child. Not daring to enter the church, he knelt humbly on the ground outside and prayed, tearfully telling the Lord of his great desire to offer a gift. Unwilling to approach with empty hands, he finally rose only to behold springing up at his feet a plant with dazzling red, spectacular blossoms. This was the answer to his prayers. These blossoms he took to the feet of the Christ child.

Since then, the "flower of the Holy Night" has spread through the whole country, blooming each year at Christmas with such glorious abandon that the very sight of it fills believers with the spirit of this season of the Savior's birth. - The Catholic Source Book.

For yonder breaks a new and glorious morn.


Fall on your knees! O hear the angel voices!

In all our trials born to be our friend.








For me Christmas means the joy of family, the joy of generosity, and the joy of Christ.
