EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD - APRIL 5, 2026

Christ is risen! Truly, He is risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! Whether this is your first-time visiting with us or if you are a life-long parishioner, we rejoice to celebrate **Easter** with you! Thank you for joining us as we celebrate together the Resurrection of Jesus Christ! We no longer fear death for the death of our Savior has set us free. For this reason, **Easter** is not just an event that we remember, but a reality that we are called to live everyday of our lives.

Our liturgical life reflects the reality of our **Easter celebration** as we treat each day of the **Easter Octave** as if it was **Easter Sunday** itself. The joy of the Risen Christ cannot be contained in a single day; Instead, the effects of this great gift of salvation are felt anew in each day. For this reason, the full **Easter Season**, or **Eastertide**, lasts for *fifty days*! These *fifty days* of celebration should be lived as intensely as we lived out the past *forty days* of **Lent**.

Throughout the next forty days of **Eastertide**, we will hear of the Lord's constant appearances to His Apostles and disciples before His **Ascension**. After His **Ascension**, we spend the last ten days of **Eastertide** preparing for the descent of the Holy Spirit on **Pentecost**. For those visiting with us, we warmly invite you to remain with us like the first disciples, joining in prayer throughout all of **Eastertide** as we remain united as pilgrims of Easter joy. The doors of the Church, and the heart of Christ, always remain open to you.

Congratulations to our two Elect (Andrew and Jesse) and our two Candidates for Full Communion (Kathy and Keiron) who were received into the Church this Easter! We rejoice together as a parish to see our family continue to grow! A special "*Thank You!*" to the godparents and sponsors of our Elect and Candidates and to our OCIA Coordinator, Jill, and our OCIA Team for the diligent preparation they've helped provide throughout this past year.

Following this past year of preparation, our **Discover Catholicism** series will continue for two more weeks. During this time, those received into the Church will have the chance to reflect on the past year and the Sacraments they have just received.

PARISH RENOVATIONS—FLOOR TOUR

If this is your first time joining us in a while, you will surely have noticed something seems a little different! At the start of the New Year, we moved our weekend Masses into the **Parish Social Hall** as we began the first major renovation in the church in 40+ years. This renovation addresses a number of areas in the church (*e.g. removing asbestic materials, increasing seating capacity, etc...*) while building upon the inherent beauty of our building.

Thanks to the dedicated work of all those involved, we are on schedule. After our **Easter Sunday** Masses, you are invited upstairs into the church to view the completed terrazzo flooring with medallions designed specially for our parish. Though work in the sanctuary will continue for the next two months, the nave is itself ready for use. After deep cleaning and placement of a dust barrier, we will resume our weekend Masses in the church this month.

During the weekdays, we will continue to make use of our temporary **Daily Mass and Blessed Sacrament Chapel** in the **Conference Room** of the **Schaefer Parish Center** as construction continues in the sanctuary. The **Blessed Sacrament** remains reserved at all hours in our chapel-area and the church doors continue to be open 24/7, even during construction, for those who wish to stop by and spend time in prayer with the Eucharistic Lord.

EASTER EGG HUNT & PARISH POTLUCK

As a reminder, next Sunday we will celebrate the **Octave Day of Easter** (April 12th), known as **Divine Mercy Sunday**, with our annual **Easter Egg Hunt and Parish Potluck following the 10 AM Sunday Mass**.
