What is Confession?

Confession is the Sacrament by which sins committed after Baptism are confessed to and forgiven through the absolution of the priest.

FESS

How does the priest have the power to forgive sins?

The priest has the power to forgive sins from Jesus Christ, who said to His Apostles and to their successors in the priesthood: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you shall forgive are forgiven them." (John 20:23)

What are some of the effects of Confession?

Some of the effects of the Sacrament of Confession are: (1) the restoration or increase of sanctifying grace; (2) the forgiveness of sins; (3) the remission of the eternal punishment due because of our personal sins; and (4) help to avoid sin in the future.

What is the Seal of Confession?

The priest, as he represents Christ Himself, is bound to never reveal anything that has been confessed to him in this Sacrament.

"A final method of forgiveness is the remission of sins through penance, when the sinner does not shrink from declaring his sin to a priest of the Lord and from seeking medicine, after the manner of him who say, 'I said: To the Lord I will accuse myself of my iniquity."

DID YOU KNOW? THE SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION

The Sacrament of Confession was instituted by Jesus Christ to provide a means for those who fall into sin after Baptism to be restored into God's grace. It involves the admission of one's sins made to a duly approved Priest in order to obtain absolution. Confession is often called the "sacrament of Penance" as the recipient must be truly repentant of his sins, be determined to try to avoid this sin in the future, and be willing to make reparations as appropriate for his actions.

This Sacrament is the way in which God has chosen to administer forgiveness. Jesus exercised the power to forgive sins so "that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" (Matthew 8:6). And, to the Apostles, Jesus says: "As the Father has sent Me, so I send you. And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them: 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them..." (John 20:21-23)

The Catholic Priest, in the Sacrament of Confession, does not redeem us; he is, instead, an agent of the one Mediator, Jesus, and is assigned and empowered by this one Mediator. Confession is but one way of applying the mediation of Christ to men. In this way, the Sacrament of Confession allows us to confess our sins to God through His minister following the way in which Jesus Himself instituted.

If you haven't been to Confession in a while, I invite you to participate in this beautiful sacrament of healing. You'll be surprised about how free you feel after.
