

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY/SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER – APRIL 24, 2022

This weekend, the Church celebrates the **Second Sunday of Easter**, which is the last day in the **Octave of Easter**. It is a day that has many different names. Historically, this weekend was called "**Low Sunday**," referring to the newly baptized who, on this day, would remove the baptismal garments they received at the Easter Vigil and take their place among the Faithful. Their joining in the general assembly of the Church invites each of us to spend the fifty days of Easter reflecting on the Lord's presence in the sacramental life of the Church.

At the beginning of the new millennium, Pope St. John Paul II named this weekend as "The Second Sunday of Easter, or Divine Mercy Sunday," in reference to the devotion to Divine Mercy from the Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska. This day is meant to emphasize our risen Lord's incredible and undeserved mercy given to the Apostles, seen in their ability to forgive sins (cf. John 20:19-21). As revealed to St. Faustina, our Lord wants people to trust in his mercy, to ask for it, and to allow themselves to be vessels of his mercy for others.

One of the ways that we ask for the Lord's mercy is in the *Sacrament of Reconciliation*, or *Confession*. In *Confession*, we come into contact with and receive the Lord's Divine Mercy. As a reminder, this Sacrament is offered to us at all times throughout the year. If you are in the habit of only going to Confession during the penitential seasons of Advent and Lent, this is the perfect time to make a commitment to make more frequent use of this Sacrament. This allows our Lord's mercy to serve as a wellspring of grace that helps us to become the person that He has made us to be.

Marking the end of the **Easter Octave**, I would like to offer a special "*Thank You!*" to the many hands that made our Lent, Holy Week, Triduum, and Easter celebrations so powerful. Throughout our liturgies, we were blessed to have our hearts and minds lifted in prayer by both our Adult Choir and Children's Choir, under the direction of Teresa, our Choir Director. Our wonderful music was also beautifully matched to the wonderful decorations arranged by our *Sacred Space Committee*.

Our Master of Ceremonies, Dan, and our altar servers helped to lead us in prayer throughout our many liturgies. Thanks to their diligent efforts, our liturgies moved seamlessly throughout the week. Our RCIA Coordinator, Jill, spent the year helping to prepare our Candidate for Full Communion. And, the many hands behind the scenes, including Michelle in the Parish Office, and Nathan, Corey, and Rick provided me with invaluable support during this time (and at all other times of the year as well!).

Though the **Easter Octave** is coming to an end, the **Easter season** itself continues! This season is the longest in the Church year, lasting for fifty days. And, rightfully so! The entire Church year has led to this season: The holy longings of **Advent**, the sweet joys of **Christmas**, the contrition and penance of **Lent**, the heart-rending sight of the **Passion**, all were given us as preliminaries, as paths, to the sublime and glorious **Pasch**, which is now ours. May our rejoicing carry us into the true and never-end **Pasch**, Heaven!
