

CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY — June 14, 2020

This weekend (June 13th/14th), the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (also known as the Feast of Corpus Christi). On this day, we celebrate the great gift of the Most Holy Eucharist. In this gift, we find Jesus Christ Himself. We hold true to the words of our Savior that we hear in the sixth chapter of St. John's Gospel this weekend: "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him."

Historically, this feast day is rooted in a miracle from the mid-13th Century. In 1263, a German priest was on pilgrimage in Italy as he offered the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass at the Basilica of St. Christina in Bolsena. During the Consecration, the priest, who had been having internal doubts about the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist, lifted the Eucharist and saw that the Host was bleeding.

The priest, upon seeing the bleeding host, immediately took our Eucharistic Lord with him to the nearby city of Orvieto, where Pope Urban IV was visiting. Declared as a miracle, the corporal (the linen cloth placed on the altar) and the bleeding Host are still displayed at the church in Orvieto for veneration and adoration of our Lord. The following year (1264), Urban IV declared the Feast of Corpus Christi to serve as a joyous celebration of the Eucharist in the liturgical calendar.

I invite and encourage all of us to deepen our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist and to truly place Him at the center of our spiritual lives. How can we do this practically in our daily lives? Attend daily Mass. Participate in Eucharistic Adoration throughout the week. Visit the Church and spend time in front of our Lord in prayer. Make use of the Sacrament of Confession to be best disposed when receiving Holy Communion. Read the Bread of Life Discourse (John 6).

As I've mentioned several times, my summer classes began at the beginning of the month. Many have asked a simple question: What classes are you taking? For June, I am taking two courses: Consecrated Life and American Law for Canonists. In Consecrated Life, we are learning about consecrated life (nuns, monks, sisters, brothers, etc...) within the Church. In American Law for Canonists, we are presented with a brief overview of the American legal system and how it relates to the Church's Code of Canon Law.

As of this weekend, I will have completed the course on Consecrated Life and, for the next two weeks, will be focused on the American Law course. Each day has consisted of 4-5 hours of lectures, daily course readings, "in-class" discussions, and, over each two-week course, several assignments and examinations. At the end of the month, I will then begin the July Semester, which will offer two courses on Lay Ministry and Procedural Law.

For the next two weeks, I will be "in-class" for live discussions for most of the morning and early afternoon. Thankfully, with Fr. Felicichia's help, we will not need to change our weekday Mass schedule for this coming week. Our times will remain at 11:30 AM on Tuesday, Thursday-Saturday, and 7:00 PM on Wednesday. The following week, as Fr. Felicichia begins his first priestly assignment as Associate Pastor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Fort Wayne, we will most likely need to move to a later Mass time for weekday Mass due to my class schedule. I do not yet know my July class times or formats, so our weekday schedule for July remains up in the air. I will share more information as I receive it.


