FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - FEBRUARY 6, 2022

This weekend (Feb. 5th/6th), the Church celebrates the **Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time**. Having celebrated the **Memorial of St. Blaise** this past week (Feb. 3rd), we will offer the **Blessing of Throats** after all Masses this weekend. In this blessing, we ask St. Blaise, who is the Patron Saint of all those suffering from throat illnesses, to intercede before the Lord to protect us from all such illnesses (*if doing so would aid our eternal salvation*).

St. Blaise was the 4th Century Bishop of Sebaste (in Turkey). As recorded in the "Acts of St. Blaise," St. Blaise was arrested in 316 AD for being a Christian. While being transported to jail, a woman brought her son, choking on a fish bone, to St. Blaise, who cured the child. When imprisoned, he was gifted two candles by a woman that he aided so that he might have light in his cell. Refusing to deny Jesus Christ, St. Blaise was beaten, tortured, and beheaded by Agricola, the Roman governor of Cappadocia.

It is customary that the **Blessing of Throats** is performed by placing two candles upon the neck of the Faithful while the prayer of blessing is being prayed. The two candles recall the two candles gifted to St. Blaise in his prison cell. Placing the candles upon the neck recalls the manner in which St. Blaise gave his life to glorify God. The prayer of blessing invokes St. Blaise's intercession, recognizing that he is now before the throne of Jesus Christ, interceding on our behalf.

DID YOU KNOW? ST. PETER WAS THE FIRST POPE

Both before and after the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, St. Peter stood as the leader among the Twelve Apostles (cf. *Matthew 10; 14–17; 19; Mark 3; 8; Luke 6; 8–9; 12; John 6:68–71; Acts 1–5; 8–12; 15; Gal. 1:18; 2:11–14*). Throughout the Gospels, he is uniquely commanded by our Lord to feed His sheep (*John 21:15–17*). Jesus even prays for St. Peter's faith, that he might be prepared to strengthen his brothers (*Luke 22:31–32*).

All of this centers upon Matthew 16:13-19, in which St. Peter is named as the "Rock." And, just as the servant of King David was given the keys to open or shut (Isaiah 22), St. Peter, servant to the King of Kings, also is given the keys to "bind and loose." The Lord made St. Peter the visible foundation of his Church. He entrusted the keys of the Church to him. And, with the ongoing call of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20), this authority continues to be passed down even to our own day.

We believe that the authority given to St. Peter did not end with his life, but was handed on to his successors. This belief is based both in the Sacred Scriptures, where a successor is named for Judas (Acts 1:15-26), and in the writings of the Early Church Fathers. In the 2nd and 3rd Century, St. Irenaeus of Lyons, St. Cyprian of Carthage, Tertullian, and Hegesippus each trace the lineage of the Church in Rome from St. Peter to St. Linus, St. Cletus, and so through successors to the Pope of their own present days.

The bishop of the Church of Rome, successor to St. Peter, acts as the head of the college of bishops, is the Vicar of Christ, and serves as the Pastor of the universal Church on earth until the Lord Himself returns.

Representatives for the diocese will be present to hear from all those who would like to share how the Holy Spirit is working in their lives.


