FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT - MARCH 17, 2024

This weekend (March 16th/17th), the Church celebrates the **Fifth Sunday of Lent**, commonly referred to as **Passiontide**. As is our parish custom, we have veiled our statuary and crucifixes in purple cloth starting this weekend. These coverings will remain present, save for the crucifix in the sanctuary, until the beginning of the **Easter Vigil**.

Why is this done? In veiling our devotional items, we are visibly reminded that we are in a special time. It's one of the many changes we see come about during the *Lenten season*. Upon entering the Church itself, we immediately see that something is different. These last two weeks of **Lent** are meant to prepare us for the coming **Sacred Paschal Triduum**. This practice offers us a blunt visual reminder that we are to being preparing our hearts for the Lord.

One of the ways that we can prepare our hearts is by focusing on the words and readings of the Mass in these coming days. Next weekend, we will hear the Passion narrative read as the Gospel and are called to focus our minds on these sacred words. In veiling our statuary, we restrict a portion of our senses so that we might heighten the others and focus on what we are hearing.

As we hear these words more intently, they are meant to produce in our hearts an intensified sense of anticipation for **Easter**. How much more exciting will it be, then, when we enter the Church at **Easter** and see the statuary and crucifixes unveiled. Just as wrapping paper covers a gift that we want to unwrap, so these veils cover beautiful images that we want to see.

Just like wrapping paper on a present, these veils are not meant to be there forever. They are only temporary, waiting to be removed and show forth the great gifts that have been given. In this way, our statuary and crucifixes will soon be uncovered – in their beauty and glory – at **Easter** so that we can bask in the true gift to which they all point: The light of the Risen Lord!

PARISH PENANCE SERVICE

This coming Wednesday, March 20th, from 6:00 - 7:00 PM, I will be joined by four other priests for our Lenten Parish Penance Service. This opportunity with additional confessors, offered in addition to our weekly confession times, is but another way we can prepare our hearts for the coming joy of Easter.

I encourage you, if you haven't yet had an opportunity to make use of this truly wondrous Sacrament this *Lenten season*, join us for our penance service on Wednesday. In this great Sacrament of Confession, we hear the voice of the Savior Himself as our sins are forgiven and we receive the great gift of God's mercy. Even if it has been a long time, come and experience His mercy anew.

PALM SUNDAY PROCESSION

Next weekend, we will have the blessing of palms at all Masses as a part of our **Palm Sunday liturgies**. At the 10 AM Sunday Mass, we will begin our celebration with a procession from outside the Church. This procession helps to lead us into Holy Week as we join with the crowds welcoming Christ into Jerusalem. In the same way, we continue this journey all the way to the **Sacred Paschal Triduum**, to the joy of **Easter Sunday**, and beyond!

ST. JOSEPH'S DAY

This week, the Church celebrates both the feast days of St. Patrick (Sunday) and St. Joseph (Tuesday). As St. Joseph is our parish patron, we continue our annual celebration of the St. Joseph Table at Masses throughout this weekend. For this reason, our new St. Joseph statue is the only statue that will remain unveiled this weekend, though he will be veiled after the feast day on Tuesday.

As part of our St. Joseph Table, you are invited to take with you a sweet from the table after Mass. A special "Thank You" to those who helped arrange for this yearly treat. There is a *free will donation basket* on the table which will be donated to support activities and events for our Youth Group.
