FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DECEMBER 19, 2021

A special "Welcome Home!" to all of our university students and servicemen and women who are home for the holiday. We look forward to rejoicing together in the Nativity of our Lord Jesus on Christmas Day!

This weekend (December 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup>), the Church celebrates the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Our focus is now shifting from the first to the second half of the Advent season, from preparing for the second coming of Christ (the Parousia) to rejoicing in the Incarnation itself. Though the time for our rejoicing is near, it is not yet here. As seen in today's Gospel (Luke 1:39-45), we join in Our Lady's pregnant expectation to welcome the Savior.

We still have several days of preparation ahead. This time is not only for trimming the hearth and setting the table for Christmas, but preparing our hearts for Christ. As part of this preparation as a parish family, we will have our Advent Parish Mission offered every evening at 7 PM this Monday through Wednesday. (Each evening will also be live-streamed for those who cannot be with us in person.) We will welcome a different speaker each evening to help us as we continue to prepare for Christmas Day.

In addition to our Parish Mission, we will also have our **Advent Penance** Service this Tuesday evening (~7:30), with individual reconciliation offered following the 7:00 PM Parish Mission that evening. Fr. Daniel Koehl, our mission speaker for the evening, Fr. Bill Sullivan, and myself will be available for Confessions as long as needed. We will also still have our regular weekly times for confession offered throughout the week on Tuesday morning (8:30-9:00 AM), Wednesday evening (6:00-6:45 PM), Saturday afternoon (4:00-4:45 PM), or by appointment.

### **CHRISTMAS MASS TIMES**

We are planning and preparing to welcome not only our parish family for our Christmas liturgies, but also a number of visitors and guests. With our additional Mass times for Christmas, we hope to alleviate any overcrowding in the Church itself. If you see an individual that you may not recognize, please welcome them to the parish! May every guest joining us find in us such joy that they will be drawn irresistibly to come back and be with us each Sunday.

Each of our Christmas liturgies will have a unique feature and will be live -streamed. Our 4:00 PM Christmas Eve Vigil Mass will have the blessing of our Nativity Scene. Our 6:00 PM Christmas Eve Vigil Mass will have music led by both our Choir and our new Children's Choir. (Prior to the 6:00 PM Mass, join our Choir at 5:30 PM in the Church to join in the singing of Christmas carols.) Our Midnight Christmas Mass will be offered by candlelight. Our 9:00 AM Christmas Day Mass will welcome Fr. Bill Sullivan as celebrant.

As a reminder, we do have the obligation and opportunity to join together in worship twice this coming weekend, both for our yearly Christmas obligation and for our normal Sunday obligation. The Mass Planning Guide on the front of this bulletin can help guide your decision on which **two** Mass times you will be planning to attend and participate in for Christmas and the Feast of the Holy Family.

If you are travelling for the holiday, know of our prayers for your safe travels, for a joyous visit wherever you may be headed, and that we look forward to your return so that we may gather together again as one parish family in worship of the Lord. ~Faithfully in Christ, Fr. David




