MOST HOLY TRINITY — June 6, 2020

With the close of the Easter Season, this weeknd (June 6th/7th) brings back into the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This weekend and the next, however, have two special solemnities that will keep us from wearing the liturgical color of Ordinary Time: Green. This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity and, next weekend, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, or the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. These two solemnities put our focus on the love of God as we return to Ordinary Time.

This weekend, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity reveals to us that the eternal love of God is the uncreated first foundation and final goal of all creation, ourselves included. To quote St. Augustine from the 4th Century: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you." Or, as many parishioners might remember from their Catechism lessons, "God made us to show forth His goodness and to share with us His everlasting happiness in heaven."

Next weekend, the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi* celebrates the love of God given to us in the great gift of the Most Holy Eucharist. In this gift, Jesus Christ gives Himself to us in the most unique and real of ways. In the mid-19th Century, St. Therese of Lisieux contemplated this wondrous gift as she wrote: "Do you realize that Jesus is there in the tabernacle expressly for you - for you alone? He burns with the desire to come into your heart." God loves us; He wants us to be with Him; and He has given Himself to us at the altar so that we might be in union (communion) with Him.

As our Lord comes to us, we must desire to bring Him to every person. Following our 10 AM Mass on *Corpus Christi* (June 14th; Incense will be used at this Mass), we will have a period of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and a Eucharistic Procession around our parish campus. In this way, we proclaim our belief of Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist and bring salvation Himself out into the world. In a procession, He leads us into the world and, as His disciples, we follow behind Him (keeping an appropriate social distance as we do so). With Jesus Himself leading us, we have nothing to fear.

Congratulations Fr. Stephen Felicichia!

This Saturday (June 6th), Bishop Rhoades ordained six young men to the diaconate and one deacon to the priesthood. We congratulate Father Stephen Felicichia, as he joins our priestly fraternity and begins his priestly ministry in our Diocese. We also congratulate our six new Deacons: Logan Parrish, Augustine Onuoha, Michael Ammer, Benjamin Landrigan, Keeton Lockwood, and Paolo Degasperi. Over the years, God has granted our diocese with the blessing of many priestly vocations. Let us continue to pray for vocations throughout our diocese and from our own parish.

Fr. Felicichia has been with us these many past months since returning from the seminary and will remain in residence at St. Joseph's until he begins his first priestly assignment. Bp. Rhoades has appointed him as the new associate pastor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Fort Wayne effective June 23rd. After ordination, Fr. Felicichia celebrated his first Mass at his home parish of St. Therese in Fort Wayne. This coming weekend, he will be with us to celebrate Mass for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi and to join in our Eucharistic Procession after the 10 AM Mass.

It has been a true joy to have Fr. Felicichia in residence at St. Joseph's. He has been a tremendous ministerial help in our parish response and outreach throughout the suspension of public Masses. I've also personally enjoyed our priestly and spiritual fraternity within the rectory, forming a communal prayer routine similar to that found in the seminary. St. Joseph's wishes Fr. Felicichia the best as he prepares for his first assignment and ask that God bless him in his priestly ministry.




