

## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - JULY 20, 2025

This weekend (July 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup>), the Church celebrates the **Sixteenth Sunday** in **Ordinary Time**. We continue our journey through the Gospel of St. Luke where, last Sunday, we heard that to inherit eternal life we have to love God with all our heart, being, strength, and mind and to love our neighbor as ourselves. The Parable of the Good Samaritan offered a powerful example of what loving our neighbor as ourselves truly means.

Today, as Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary, we receive Jesus' teaching on loving God. Though Martha welcomed the Lord to her home, her attention was elsewhere. Mary, on the other hand, is sitting at His feet as a devoted disciple, listening. Jesus gently corrects Martha, reminding her that Mary had chosen the better part: Centering her day first around Him rather than trying to fit Him in after the busyness of the day has died down.

The correction shown to Martha is one that we should use within our own lives: May we put Jesus at the center of our lives, even amidst the busyness of the everyday. For, when we build our lives around Jesus in prayer and the Eucharist, we can begin to live even now the life of heaven that will one day, please God, be fulfilled forever. Our Lord will continue this theme of loving God next weekend, focusing specifically on prayer (Luke 11:1-13).

After five months of bulletin covers highlighting the lives of the Saints, we're trying out a new "default" bulletin cover for the summer months. This new cover combines both old and new elements from our parish in this anniversary year. At the top, our new parish logo is highlighted. Central to the cover is a drawing of St. Joseph and the Christ-child that first appeared on our bulletin covers in the 1980s.

The practice of preserving older bulletins was fairly common in the mid-tolate twentieth century, especially when our bulletins were published through a publishing house. At the end of each year, the publishing house would send the parish a bound collection of the past year's bulletins. Depending on what these annuals might contain, you may see a few other "throwback" images on the bulletin covers for a bit of variety.

When the need arises, we will still make use of the bulletin cover for both educational material and promotion of events. As such covers have been prepared through our parish office, however, they require more time and effort to create. Having a "default" cover helps to ensure that we'll always have a bulletin cover ready for print and help to make our bulletin look more familiar and easily identifiable.

## TOTUS TUUS - WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE

Please note, our weekday Mass schedule will be fairly different this week to better accommodate the Totus Tuus Summer Youth Program. Daily Mass will be offered Monday through Friday at 11:15 AM this week. Adoration will be offered on Wednesday from 7:15-8:15 PM and Thursday from 1:25-2:25 PM. Confessions will be offered on Tuesday following the 11:15 AM Mass and is available by appointment.

Following the conclusion of Totus Tuus on Friday evening, our weekday Mass schedule will return to normal with Mass at 8 AM on Saturday with Confessions offered after the 8 AM Mass. Our weekend Mass schedule remains unchanged, with Confessions offered from 4-4:45 PM on Saturday afternoon before the 5 PM Vigil Mass and our Sunday morning Masses at 7:30 AM and 10 AM. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
