SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - FEBRUARY 15, 2026

This weekend (February 14th/15th), the Church celebrates the **Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time**. On Wednesday, we move from **Ordinary Time** into the penitential season of **Lent**. These coming forty days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving will commence with the sprinkling of ashes on **Ash Wednesday**. Having been instructed in the path of discipleship these past many weeks, we now carry into **Lent** all that we have learned as we strive to grow in Christ.

Thank you to all those who volunteered at and participated in our **Parish Listening Sessions** for the *Diocesan Synod*. Between two sessions, we had 31 participants. We will compile a report from what was shared touching upon the five areas of reflection: *Evangelization, Catechesis, Spiritual & Liturgical Life, Outreach, and Vocations*. This report will be shared with Bishop Rhoades to aid in his preparation for the *Diocesan Synod* in November.

ASH WEDNESDAY—WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 18TH

As our forty days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving begin this Wednesday, we will offer three Mass times for **Ash Wednesday** (February 18th) at **7:00 AM, Noon, and 7:00 PM**. As is customary, we will offer the imposition of ashes during each Mass. Ashes have a long scriptural history as an outward sign of humility and penance. This visible sign is meant to reflect our hearts as we begin forty days striving for a deeper conversion and growth in Christ.

Please remember, **Ash Wednesday (February 18th) is a day of abstinence and fasting**. On this day, we abstain from meat (*as we also do every Friday throughout Lent*) and limit ourselves to one normal and two small meals throughout the day. These biblical practices of fasting (*Matthew 9:14-15*) and abstinence (*Daniel 10:2-3*) strengthen our self-discipline and remind us that our true end is not here on earth, but in heaven.

LENTEN PARISH DEVOTIONS

In addition to our personal Lenten observances that we discern to follow this year, the parish is offering a number of additional opportunities for prayer throughout Lent. This not only includes our regular weekday Mass, Adoration, and Confession schedules, but also a number of special Lenten offerings added to the schedule. Make sure to follow along with the Parish Calendar in the bulletin each weekend for a full schedule of these offerings.

Starting this Friday (February 20th), we will begin our weekly **Soup Suppers at 5:30 PM** in the Parish Gym. From **6:00 - 6:45 PM**, we will offer a series on Prayer as a part of our Soup Suppers. We will follow along with and discuss Dr. Tim Gray's "*Prayer: Finding Intimacy with God*" from the **Augustine Institute**. Afterwards, you are invited to join us in praying the **Stations of the Cross at 7 PM** in the Parish Social Hall.

ESTATE AND FUNERAL PLANNING PRESENTATION

At the end this month, we will be hosting a presentation on **estate and funeral planning**. We will welcome an expert in estate planning to provide practical guidance on preparing your affairs and members of the *Catholic Community Foundation of Northeast Indiana* to discuss our **St. Joseph Endowment Fund** and opportunities for planned giving. Afterwards, I will explain the Church's vision for Catholic funeral planning and why the funeral rites matter for our faith and our families.

Given the importance of this topic, we are offering the same presentation twice to make it as available to you as possible. **The presentation will be offered in the Parish Gym on both Monday evening, February 23rd from 6:30-7:30 PM and Thursday afternoon, February 26th from 1:30-2:30 PM.** We will have a variety of material available, including information about *St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery*, our parish Funeral Planning Packets, and information about our local funeral homes.
