## THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - DECEMBER 14, 2025

Thank you to all those who participated in our **Forty Hours Devotion and Consecration to St. Joseph** this past week. May this time given to the Lord bear tremendous fruit in both our lives and the life of our parish.

This weekend (Dec. 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>), the Church celebrates the **Third Sunday of Advent**, also known as **Gaudete Sunday** or **Rejoice Sunday**. This name comes from the beginning of the Entrance Antiphon for today's Mass: **Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice!** (*Philippians 4:4*) This brief moment of joy during a penitential season marks the halfway point of **Advent** and emphasizes that the One we await is already drawing near.

The expectant and hope-filled joy of this day is reflected in the rose-colored vestments worn by the priest and the rose Advent candle, both of which mix the penitential violet of Advent with the joyful gold of Christmastide. We also raise our voices for a recessional hymn today, breaking our musical fast for a day's time as a reminder of what silence is meant to prepare us for: That glorious day when "*all God's people shall see together the glory of the Lord.*"

On Wednesday (Dec. 17<sup>th</sup>), the Church will fully change her **Advent** focus from the second coming of Christ to His coming on **Christmas Day** as we begin the recitation of the "*O Antiphons.*" The "*O Antiphons*" are formally recited as a part of *Vespers (Evening Prayer)* at the Liturgy of the Hours, the daily prayer of the Church. Dating back to at least the 6<sup>th</sup> Century, each antiphon is an Old Testament messianic prophecy fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

By the 8<sup>th</sup> Century, the "*O Antiphons*" were in regular use throughout Rome. It is believed that Benedictine monks were the first to arrange these antiphons with a definite purpose and order: Working in reverse order, the first letter of each antiphon spells out **E-R-O C-R-A-S**, Latin for "**Tomorrow, I come to you.**" As the "*O Antiphons*" end on **Christmas Eve**, this phrase anticipates the coming joy of the Christ-child on **Christmas Day**.

In our modern day, these antiphons are recognizable from both the Alleluia verse at daily Mass and the lyrics of "*O Come, O Come, Emmanuel.*" The repeated use of "*Come!*", crescendo-ing with each verse, is meant to emphasize our intense longing and desire for the LORD. In the same way, these four weeks of **Advent** are meant to awaken us from slumber, stoke the flames of our hearts, and prepare us to welcome our SAVIOR on **Christmas Day**.

### ADVENT PENANCE SERVICE—DEC. 17<sup>TH</sup> FROM 6:00-7:00 PM

Our **Advent Penance Service** is **Wednesday, December 17<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 - 7:00 PM** in the Church. We will be joined by three priests to hear confessions. I would encourage you to welcome the peace that is Jesus Christ by coming to the Sacrament of Confession. Here, the Lord heals, strengthens, and reconciles our souls through the power of His forgiveness. In this way, we prepare our hearts for **Christmas Day** by giving it over entirely to the Lord.

### PARISH RENOVATIONS—VOLUNTEER WORK DAYS

Though Shawnee Construction will formally begin work on our church renovations Monday, Jan. 5<sup>th</sup>, we will begin "preparations" for the renovations **following the 10 AM Mass on Sunday, Dec. 28<sup>th</sup>**. **Volunteers are welcome to join us after Mass, from 11 AM - 1 PM** to move furniture from the Church to the Parish Social Hall, move tables from the Parish Social Hall to the Parish Gym, and begin arranging chairs in the Parish Social Hall.

On Monday, Dec. 29<sup>th</sup>, local **Yaste Painting** will remove the pews from the Church to begin the needed repair work and re-staining. We will have a second **Volunteer Work Day on Tuesday, Dec. 30<sup>th</sup> from 1 PM - 3 PM**. On this day, we will begin disassembling cabinets in the sacristy, transitioning the Youth Den into a Calming Room / Cry Room, and tackle a number of other projects as we prepare to celebrate our first Masses in the Parish Social Hall. Please come dressed in work clothes if volunteering on this day.
