

## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER - APRIL 23, 2023

This weekend (April 22nd/23rd), the Church celebrates the **Third Sunday of Easter**. As we are not yet even at the halfway point of the **Easter season**, our celebration is meant to continue for several more weeks. As much as we are called to celebrate these many weeks, we might begin to grow weary of this celebration. To remain in *Easter joy* can become quite tiring as we face the trials and struggles of everyday life.

As we continue in **Eastertide**, we remember Pope St. John Paul II's remark that our celebration of the Resurrection does not remove the sadness and sin of our world. It does, however, make us an Easter People "and Hallelujah is our song!" During these fifty days celebrating the Resurrection, we are invited to deepen our faith and increase our trust in the Risen Lord Himself. If we are willing to share in His daily death to self, we too can share in the joy of His rising everyday of our life.

## WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

This past week, I spent four days in Emmitsburg, Maryland, at Mount St. Mary's Seminary. These days offered a wonderful opportunity to visit with our thirteen diocesan seminarians studying for the priesthood. (We have another four men studying at the North American College in Rome.) I am always edified when spending time with these young men as they prepare to serve our local Church. This coming June 3rd, seven of these men will be ordained as priests for our diocese and be assigned as associate pastors in our various parishes.

Next year, we will have, for the first time in nearly a decade, just over ten men studying for the priesthood in our diocese (*often having twenty to thirty*). Though this number often rises and falls, it is a good reminder of our need to constantly pray for vocations. In our parish, we are blessed to have many couples entering into the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony, with four couples approaching the Sacrament this year. We also want to continue our prayers for men and women from our parish to discern vocations in both priestly and religious life (*something we pray for every weekend in our Vocation Prayer*).

All three of these vocations (Marriage, Priesthood, and Religious Life) are vocations of service. In them, we serve the Lord through our daily lives lived for our spouses and children or the Church and Her people. Next weekend, the latter two vocations are highlighted as we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Easter, also known as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Instituted by Pope St. Paul VI in 1964, this day of prayer falls every year as we hear the Gospel reading of the Good Shepherd. It is a good reminder to not only pray for, but to actively encourage and welcome vocations to grow from within our own community.

## **ECCE** YOUNG ADULT CHOIR CONCERT

Next Sunday (April 30th), we are privileged to host the Ecce Young Adult Choir from Fort Wayne at 1 PM for an afternoon Easter concert. I hope that you will take advantage of this opportunity to enjoy a beautiful musical afternoon concert this Easter season. In addition to the concert, the *Ecce* Young Adult Choir will also be joining us for and providing music at our 10 AM Mass next Sunday in anticipation of their concert later that afternoon.

Join us for a potluck / pitch-in after Mass and before the concert in the Parish Social Hall for some parish fraternity and a chance to meet the members of the *Ecce* Young Adult Choir. All are welcome!
