We will continue to walk with the Lord through this gospel until the end of the liturgical year with the **Solemnity of Christ the King** in November.

As we continue this walk through the **Gospel of St. Mark**, our focus will be on the Christian life. As we have already celebrated those great events (e.g. the Incarnation, the Resurrection, etc...) that mark salvation history, we now see the fruits of these events put into action. As Christ has come into the world, so now He sends His Church to proclaim the Good News. And, we, as members of His Body, proclaim this good news in our very lives.

Bishop Rhoades has asked all parishes to take up a special collection for the residents of Haiti. As we have recently seen in the news, Haiti has been subjected to a horrible earthquake and terrible storms that have caused much destruction. 


